

10 Technical Interview Tips

1 RESEARCH

Show your interest in the company you're applying for. Read about the projects, events, culture, size, collect information. Commonly, the HR person will ask about - "How many people work in our company?" or similar.

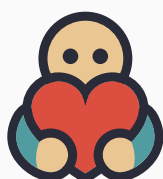


2 STUDY YOUR CV

Be honest with your knowledge, prepare with each technology and skill you have added to it.

3 SOFT SKILLS

Communication, looking in the eyes, self-confidence, training with the mirror, practicing speech, not losing control during the interview are all important aspects to succeed.



4 SYMPATHY

Smile and say Hi, according to the Rule of Sympathy, the recruiter should do the same and the interview will be much easier.

5 PRACTICE

Do code challenges, algorithms, logical tasks to be better prepared for them during the interview.



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6 PREPARE Q&A

Questions to ask could be: “What are the benefits?”, “What is the project that I am applying for?”, “How many people are in the team?”. Answers you need to prepare: “What was the biggest challenge you faced in your career?”, “Describe your previous work experience”.



7 MOCK INTERVIEW

8 RELIEVE STRESS

Do breathing exercises, meditate. Try to understand your emotions and how to control them, find something that relaxes you, especially before the interview.



9 TAKE CARE

Sleep, eat, and drink well. You need to recover and be full of energy for your interview. You don't want to be late, hungry or dehydrated, simple things, but under the pressure, it's easy to forget about them.

10 SURPRISE EVERYONE

Geek things are welcome to the technical interview. Tell the difference between Progressive Enhancement and Graceful Degradation, add something interesting between the answers.
